Attention Residential Customers:

Citizens of Anthony we need your help. The discharges of grease, towels, rags, oil, and debris to our sewers are impacting the operation of our collection and treatment systems. These discharges are prohibited and need to stop. The impacts are raising our costs to operate and maintain the system, which in turn could affect your water and sewer bills. Additionally they are affecting the performance of our wastewater plant, which could result in violations and fines imposed on us by state regulators. This in turn affects our costs and could affect your water and sewer bills.

Users found to be discharging materials into the sanitary sewer system that adversely impact the operation of the system or plant could be held responsible for any related expense incurred by the Town of Anthony including cleaning the affected lines, added equipment maintenance/ replacements, and any damage to public or private property.

We are calling on you to help us with this situation.

Oil/ Grease- Cool it, Can it, Cover it, and Dispose of it in the trash

Towels and Rags- Dispose of it in the trash

Used Motor Oil- Recycle it. Call the Town of Anthony for nearest Recycle location.

We appreciate your support in helping us correct this situation by properly disposing of these materials and keeping them out of our wastewater system.
